There are eviction protections and financial programs available to help.

Here is what you need to know about the eviction and foreclosure moratorium in Massachusetts:

- Right now in Massachusetts, there is a state-wide moratorium, or temporary pause, on evictions and foreclosures.
- This temporarily stops all non-emergency evictions and foreclosures for all types of households **until October 17, 2020.**
- You still need to pay rent.
