**Subject:** FutureSkills Initiative and Regional Upskilling Roadshows

Purpose: To provide MassHire Workforce Boards, MassHire Career Center Operators and

other local workforce investment partners with information on the FutureSkills

Initiative and Regional Upskilling Roadshows.

Background: The Commonwealth's Workforce Skills Cabinet (WSC), charged with creating and

implementing strategies to ensure that individuals develop and continuously improve their skills and knowledge to meet the varying hiring needs of employers will invest \$240M in combined state and American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds over the next four years to build capacity of education and training

systems in Massachusetts.

#### **FutureSkills Initiative**

Through the "FutureSkills" (Upskilling) Initiative, the WSC has invested ARPA funds to expand the scale of "upskilling" pathways across education, training, and workforce providers in partnership with employers that prepare

unemployed and underemployed individuals with the training and skills needed to meet business demand.

Commonwealth Corporation, on behalf of the Executive Office of Labor and Workforce Development and the WSC, will administer training programs under the umbrella of the FutureSkills Initiative. These training programs include:

- Career Technical Initiative (CTI),
- Workforce Competitiveness Trust Fund (WCTF),
- Replenishing Employer investment in Education and Workforce Training (RENEW)

## **FutureSkills Regional Upskilling Roadshows**

The Commonwealth of Massachsuetts, including MassHire Career Centers, MassHire Workforce Boards and the Commonwealth Corporation, is hosting a series of 10 regional employer road shows from late April to May, with the goal of connecting employers to new and existing workforce supports from the Commonwealth.
