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- **Purpose:** This document provides additional guidance for Local Workforce Development Boards (Local Boards), WIOA Required Partners (OSCC Core Partners) and other stakeholders (as locally defined) regarding the development and submission of the WIOA Joint Partner Local Umbrella MOU.
- **Background:** WIOA emphasizes full and effective partnerships between Local Boards and One-Stop Career Center Required Partners and other Partners (as locally defined) to improve job and career options for youth, job seekers, and businesses through collaboration in designing integrated services that place the customer at the center of the service delivery.

In accordance with WIOA Regulations 20 CFR § 678.500, the level Umbrella MOU, a product of local discussion and negotiation, is an agreement developed and executed between the Local Board and the One-Stop Parage's relating to the operation of the one-stop service delivery system in the local action.

The local Umbrella MOU is a tool that will define service beivery methods and establish a stable and equitable funding stream for orboing one-stop operations. The MOU shall be developed in accordance whe WIO sec. 121(c) (1) Memorandum of Understanding – Development, Sto Local Board, with the agreement of the Chief Elected Official shall develop and enter into a memorandum of understanding (between the Local Board and the One-Stop Partners) concerning the partnership of integration of services within the local area." WIOA allows the option of the development of a single "umbrella" MOU for a local area versus multiple orderent memoranda between Local Boards and each Partner (20 CFR § 678 505). Massachusetts' state-level Partners have elected to implement the unorella MOU model.

Definitions:

Ope-Stop Caree. Center (OSCC) Required Partner: the Partners who are ideal field order W OA and included within the Massachusetts Combined State Plan holude. LooA Title I (Adult, Dislocated Worker, Youth); Title II (Adult institution and Family Literacy); Title III (Wagner Peyser/Employment Service); Title IV (vocational Rehabilitation); Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (in NF); Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP); Unemployment Institution (UI); Trade Adjustment Assistance (TAA); Jobs for Veterans State Grant (JVSG) and the Senior Community Service Employment Program (SCSEP).

Shared Customer: OSCC Required Partners have agreed that youth, job seekers, and businesses who receive services from more than one OSCC Required Partner are considered "shared" customers. Shared customers benefit from services and resources delivered across multiple OSCC Partners and other stakeholders that are aligned to meet an individuals needs.

Policy: The Local Board convenes OSCC Required Partners and other stakeholders (as defined locally) to discuss, develop, negotiate and execute a WIOA Joint Partner Local Umbrella MOU that specifies how services will be connected, integrated, or jointly designed in ways that improve outcomes for shared customers.

Local Boards continue to convene the local partners in order to implement and refine the Local Umbrella MOUs. Negotiations of a "refreshed" WIOA Joint Partner Local Umbrella MOU will be complete on or before June 30, 2018 and result in a fully executed Umbrella MOU by July 1, 2018, with an effective period of no longer than three years (July 1, 2018 – June 30, 2021.)

Note: The MOU is a fluid document and must be revised as appropriate to reflect changes to service delivery or funding methodologies.

In the event that the One-Stop Partners, Local Board and SCC Pequired Partners are unable to reach agreement (defined in VIOA a "Impasse") with regard to how local One-Stop services will be joinely denoted and funded, the Local Board must notify the State Board, Genemor, and the State Workforce Agency as described in Attachment D.

Required: The Local Board will convene the OSCC Required Partners and other stakeholders (as defined locally) to develop coordinated service delivery strategies for youth, job seekers, and businesses. The Local Board will engage with the OSCC Required Partners and other stakeholder to strategize integrated,

person-centric service design and delivery within the One-Stop Career Center. The updated OSCC service design will be articulated in the "refreshed" Local WIOA Joint Partner Umbrella MOU effective July 1, 2018.
