Funds will be utilized consistent with WIOA infrastructure funding requirements for WIOA mandated OSCC partners and to implement the requirements of this ISA.

B. Use of these funds will include including the use of office space and furnishing.

a. Responsibility of MDCS

- Distribute and manage funds provided under this ISA to effectively support coordinated efforts at the MCCs for shared customers.
- Provide an outreach and referral system for shared customers.
- Provide a quarterly report to WIOA Partners on the number of older workers age 55 and older served, the number of referrals to MA SCSEP, and the types of activities and services provided to non-MA SCSEP older workers.

b. Responsibility of EOEA

- Make federal DOL funds available to MDCS as specified in this agreement
- Co-locate MA SCSEP staff at MCCs in the areas of service
- Provide MCCs with information on equitable distribution of MSCSEP tots
- Coordinate between National and MA SCSEP sub granted
- Provide training to MDCS and MCCs on the employent needs of older workers and the value of older workers to local employes.
- Participate in design of the career path ys for one workers with MDCS and MCCS.
- Provide MDCS and MCCs information and eferrals to multiple elder network programs and supportive services, i.e., SHINA Meals on Wheels, Healthy Aging resources, Senior Housing and Caregivers programs.

c. Responsibility of MassHire Cere Centers (MCCs)

- Provide a single point of contactor MASCSEP in each MCC.
- Designate appropriation of the Mcs.
- Document MA Sc. EP participant enrollment, assessment, placement, training and outcomes and stablish an individual case record for each participant. Case record will be parted with all WIOA Partners and will contain at a minimum; documentation of skill assessments, evaluation of activities, case notes, and animality service referrals.
- Identify eligibary shared customers.
- Provide job placement, earnings, and job retention data for shared customers.
- Promote older workers and shared customers to employers.
