## Partner Responsibilities:

### SCSEP

A combination of Outstationed Staff and Navigator Staff physically located at the career centers to:

- Provide training/information to MCC staff regarding services and resources provided.
- Provide training/information to MCC staff on SCSEP eligibility requirements, assessment, and placement into SCSEP.
- Develop an Individual Employment Plan (IEP) for SCSEP eligible individuals.
- Provide paid Community Service Assignment (CSA) for SCSEP enrolled individuals.
- Coordinate case management and job development services with all partners.
- Assist the MCC in developing targeted programming and conduct workshops for MCC clients.
