Subject: Workforce Plan Public Comment Period and Virtual Public Sessions

- Purpose:To notify MassHire Workforce Boards, MassHire Career Center Operators, and
other local workforce partners of the PY2024 2027 Massachusetts
Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) Workforce Plan public
comment period and virtual public sessions.
- **Background:** The Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) requires the submission of a State Plan that includes a four-year strategy and operational plan for the implementation of the state's workforce development system.

WIOA requires states to provide the opportunity for public comment and input which allows interested stakeholders to participate actively, effectively, and transparently in the development of the plan, including via accessible means for individuals with disabilities.

Massachusetts seeks to fulfill this requirement through a public comment period process consisting of feedback through a web-based platform and two virtual public sessions. The public comment period is January 29, 2024 – February 12, 2024. Dates and times for the two virtual public sessions are listed below.

The PY2024 – 2027 (July 1, 2024 – June 30, 2028) Massachusetts WIOA Workforce Plan will be made available for public review and comment beginning Monday, January 29, 2024.

The Executive Office of Labor and Workforce Development will hold two virtual public comment sessions on the draft state workforce plan. As part of the Workforce Innovation Opportunity Act (WIOA), the U.S. Department of Labor requires all states to submit a state plan. Massachusetts' draft plan sets forth the Healey-Driscoll Administration's workforce agenda, provides a framework in coordination with major public workforce system partners, represents over \$400 million in partnership with several state agencies, outlines the collaboration between state and local workforce partners, and builds consensus across focus areas, strategies, and stakeholders.

The vision, goals, and strategies outlined in the draft Massachusetts State Plan center on increasing equity, leveraging pathways to close the skills gap and meet industry demands, and ensure Massachusetts' workers, untapped talent, and rising talent are positioned for success and employers can access the talent they need to thrive. The State Plan outlines strategies on: 1) Talent Attraction and Retention, 2) Talent Development, 3) Lead by Example, and 4) Workforce System Infrastructure.

At the public comment sessions, interested stakeholders are invited to provide feedback, input, and relevant data and information. Feedback received during the public comment sessions will be reviewed before the State Plan is finalized. US

DOL requires all state plans to be submitted by March 4, 2024. Public comment can also be shared online upon viewing the draft State Plan. The link to the PY2024 – 2027 Massachusetts WIOA Workforce Plan is located <u>here</u>.
