

FY2025 Adult and Community Learning Services (ACLS)

Adult Career Pathways Funds

The purpose of these funds is for the involvement of local workforce board staff (1) in supporting adult education programs in the local workforce areas in the development of career pathways and programing for adult learners enrolled in adult education programs and (2) to join ACLS staff in review of proposals, program quality reviews and site visits in their local workforce areas.

The methodology used to distribute funds to each of the 16 MassHire Workforce Boards is based on FY2024 adult education enrollments in each local workforce area:
