Subject: Open Meeting Lay Subjects of Certain Provisions

Purpose: To provide information to Chief Elected Officials and MassHire Workforce Boards

regulating he suspension of certain provisions of the Open Meeting Law,

G.L.e. 34, 5.

Background: On March 12, 2020, Governor Baker issued an Executive Order modifying certain

requirements of the Open Meeting Law, to enable public bodies to carry out their esponsibilities while adhering to public health recommendations regarding

social distancing.

**Policy:** The Executive Order relieves public bodies from the requirement in the Open

Meeting Law that meetings be conducted in a public place that is open and physically accessible to the public, provided that the public body makes provision

to ensure public access to the deliberations of the public body through adequate, alternative means. "Adequate, alternative means" may include, without limitation, providing public access through telephone, internet, or satellite enabled audio or video conferencing or any other technology that

enables the public to clearly follow the proceedings of the public body in real time. A municipal public body that for reasons of economic hardship and despite best efforts is unable to provide alternative means of public access in real time may instead post on its municipal website a full and complete transcript, recording, or other comprehensive record of the proceedings as soon as practicable afterwards.

In addition, all members of a public body may participate in a meeting remotely; the Open Meeting Law's requirement that a quorum of the body and the chair be physically present at the meeting location is suspended.

All other provisions of the Open Meeting Law, such as the requirements regarding posting notice of meetings and creating and maintaining accurate meeting minutes, as well as the limited, enumerated purposes for holding an executive session, remain in effect.
