**Policy:** On March 19, 2020, the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) issued a Memorandum providing "Administrative Relief for Recipients and Applicants Directly impacted by the Novel Coronavirus".

This policy issuance provides a short-term suspension of local level programmatic monitoring requirements due to the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) crisis. The short-term suspension of local board monitoring is time limited.

The OMB will be conducting a reassessment within ninety (90) days of the issuance of their March 19, 2020 memo. The MassHire Department of Career Services (MDCS) will reissue an updated policy following that reassessment and guidance by OMB and additional guidance provided by the United tates Department of Labor (USDOL).
