WHY FOCUS ON DECONSTRUCTION AND REUSE?

- Disposal capacity shortfall- in state and in the northeast
- Little appetite or interest in developing new capacity
- Want to divert materials and capture environmental/ economic value, and drive market development
- Aggressive Waste Reduction goals in SWMP: Reduce overall disposal by 1.7M ton annually by 2030
 - Target: Reduce disposal of C&D materials by 260K tons by 2030, more than double current C&D recycling tonnage.

We need to improve the way we are managing these materials.
