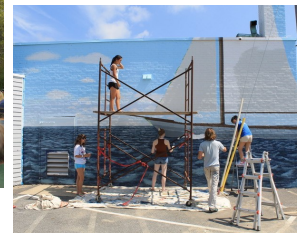
Opportunity Zone Goals
