DECISION

SAILING COW CORP. D/B/A SAILING COW 170 OLD WHARF RD. DENNISPORT, MA 02670 LICENSE#: 1518-00117

VIOLATION DATE: 6/13/2018 HEARING DATE: 9/04/2018

Sailing Cow Corp. d/b/a Sailing Cow (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, September 4, 2018, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) — Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, § 34 — Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the Licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Velez's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

- 1. Investigator Velez's Compliance Check Field Report; and
- 2. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

The Commission took Administrative Notice of the Licensee's record.

FACTS

- 1. On Wednesday, June 13, 2018, at approximately 6:40 p.m., Investigators Binienda and Velez ("Investigators") investigated the business of Sailing Cow Corp. d/b/a Sailing Cow.
- 2. An underage operative, working with Investigators, purchased from the Licensee an alcoholic beverage, a pint of Cape Cod Red beer, for five dollars (\$5.00). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, § 34 – Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. As the Licensee has been in business for over 10 years with no prior violations, the Commission issues a **WARNING**.
