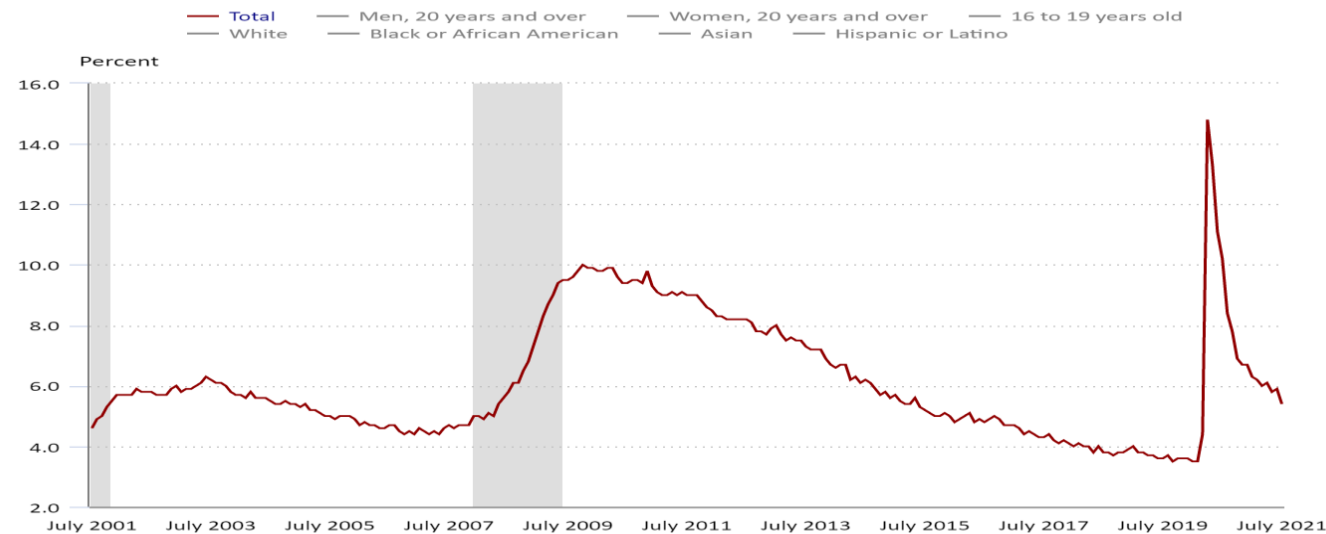
## Featured Speaker

- In April of 2020, the unemployment rate in MA skyrocketed to a high of 16.4%. According to the [U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics](#), the unemployment rate in MA is currently 4.9%, where other states have unemployment rates as high as 8.1%.
