Notice of Contract Opportunity Invitation for Bids (IFB) DFW-2021-034 Brush Mowing and Mulching at the Montague Plains WMA, Montague, MA

Project Summary

MassWildlife is seeking bids from Contractors to conduct important habitat restoration work during Fiscal Year 2021 on up to 177 acres at the Montague Plains Wildlife Management Area (WMA) located in Montague, Massachusetts. Treatments to be conducted include re-mowing/mulching of tree stump sprouts in previously thinned woodland and mowing/mulching of understory shrubs as well as the creation of a firebreak .3 miles long and 20 ft wide.

The principal objective of this project is to restore an open canopy oak woodland with remnant pitch pine above a dense shrub layer of scrub oak, lowbush blueberry, and other native herbs and shrubs associated with sandplain and barrens communities. Some of these communities are both regionally and globally imperiled and support multiple state-listed species. These unique plant communities also benefit native songbirds, game birds, and pollinating insects such as native bees, butterflies & moths. Prescribed fire and mowing/mulching are used to restore and maintain these communities, and removal of excess woody fuels is needed to facilitate safe and effective use of prescribed fire.

The Estimated Project cost is \$100,000.00.

Mandatory bid conference will be held at 2:00 pm on Thursday, February 25, 2021. Meet at the Montague Plains WMA parking area off Lake Pleasant Road (42.569118, -72.513939).

Bid Deadline:. Sealed Bids must be received, in writing, no later than Friday, March 5, 2021 at 2:00 pm, at which time bids will be publicly opened and read.



MassWildlife shall extend a remote access invitation to potential bidders that have provided a valid email address in order to witness the public bid opening.



Instructions to obtain bid documents from Commbuys


1. Go to www.commbuys.com



3. On the Advanced Search page, click the drop down box and select bid solicitations.



4. In the Bid Description Box type the project number: DFW-2021-018 and click Search.
