THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS: NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

The Massachusetts Division of Fisheries and Wildlife (MassWildlife) is seeking written quotes to remove an existing damaged wooden fence and install a new, approximately 151 feet in total length, rectangular, 10' tall (8' tall panels) vinyl fence with a latching double gate at the MassWildlife Field Headquarters at 1 Rabbit Hill Road, Westborough, MA 01581. All work must be completed no later than January 31, 2025.

The Estimated Project cost is \$25,000.00.

Complete project specifications may be obtained at www.commbuys.com. In the bid description box enter DFW-2026-027 and click Find It (see detailed instructions below).

Pre-Bid Conference: A non-mandatory bidder's conference is planned for November 26, 2025 at 10:00 AM. Meet in the lobby of the MassWildlife Field Headquarters at 1 Rabbit Hill Road, Westborough, MA. Please email Trina Moruzzi at Trina.Moruzzi@mass.gov if you plan on attending the bidders conference no later than November 24, 2025.

Bid Opening: Written Quotes should be submitted using the Mandatory Form of the General Bid Sheet provided with the RFQ. **Written Quotes must be received no later than 10:00 am EST on December 8, 2025. There is no formal public bid opening for this project.**

The contract will be awarded to the lowest responsible and eligible bidder for the treatment described on the Mandatory Bid Sheets. The term "lowest responsible and eligible bidder" shall mean (1) the Bidder whose Bid is the lowest of those Bidders demonstrably possessing the skill, ability, and integrity necessary for the faithful performance of the work, and who meets the requirements set forth in M.G.L. c.149 sec.44 (2)(B) and not debarred from bidding under M.G.L. c.149 §44C; (2) and who shall certify that they are able to furnish labor that can work in harmony with all other elements of labor employed or to be employed on the work; and (3) who shall certify that all employees to be employed at the worksite will have successfully completed a course in construction safety and health approved by the United States Occupational Safety and Health Administration that is at least 10 hours in duration at the time the employee begins work, and who shall furnish documentation of successful completion of said course with the first certified payroll report for each employee.

MassWildlife reserves the right to waive any informalities in, or to reject any or all Bids, if it be in the public interest to do so.



Instructions to obtain bid documents from Commbuys


1. Go to www.commbuys.com

2. At the top of the screen, click on the advanced search option
