THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS: NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

The Massachusetts Division of Fisheries & Wildlife (MassWildlife) is soliciting written quotes from Contractors for tree cutting of 11 acres at **Tree Cutting at William Forward WMA, Newbury, MA**. All work must be completed no later than March 1, 2025.

The Estimated Project cost is \$33,000.00.

Complete project specifications may be obtained at www.commbuys.com. In the bid description box enter DFW-2026-028 and click Find It (see detailed instructions below).

Pre-Bid Conference: A mandatory bidders conference will be held at **10:00 am on Monday, October 27, 2025**. Meet at Kents Island WMA parking lot (coordinates are 42.7716359°, -70.8744164°) off Hay Street, Newbury, MA.

Bid Opening: Written Quotes should be submitted using the Mandatory Form of the General Bid Sheet provided with the RFQ. **Written Quotes must be submitted no later than 10:00 am EST on Thursday, November 6, 2025. There is no formal public bid opening for this project.**

The contract will be awarded to the lowest responsible and eligible bidder for the treatment described on the Mandatory Bid Sheets. The term "lowest responsible and eligible bidder" shall mean (1) the Bidder whose Bid is the lowest of those Bidders demonstrably possessing the skill, ability, and integrity necessary for the faithful performance of the work, and who meets the requirements set forth in M.G.L. c.149 sec.44 (2)(B) and not debarred from bidding under M.G.L. c.149 §44C; (2) and who shall certify that they are able to furnish labor that can work in harmony with all other elements of labor employed or to be employed on the work; and (3) who shall certify that all employees to be employed at the worksite will have successfully completed a course in construction safety and health approved by the United States Occupational Safety and Health Administration that is at least 10 hours in duration at the time the employee begins work, and who shall furnish documentation of successful completion of said course with the first certified payroll report for each employee.

MassWildlife reserves the right to waive any informalities in, or to reject any or all Bids, if it be in the public interest to do so.

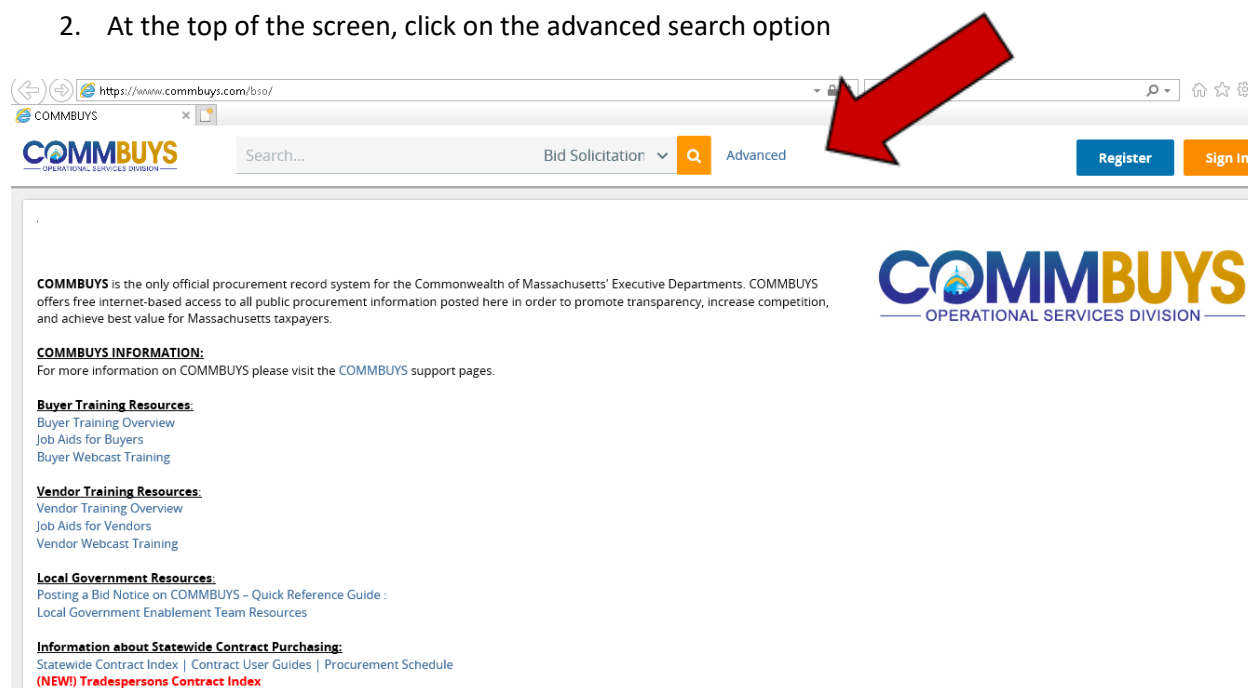

account when obtaining the specification documents you WILL NOT be automatically added to the plan holders list and may not be notified of project updates and addenda.

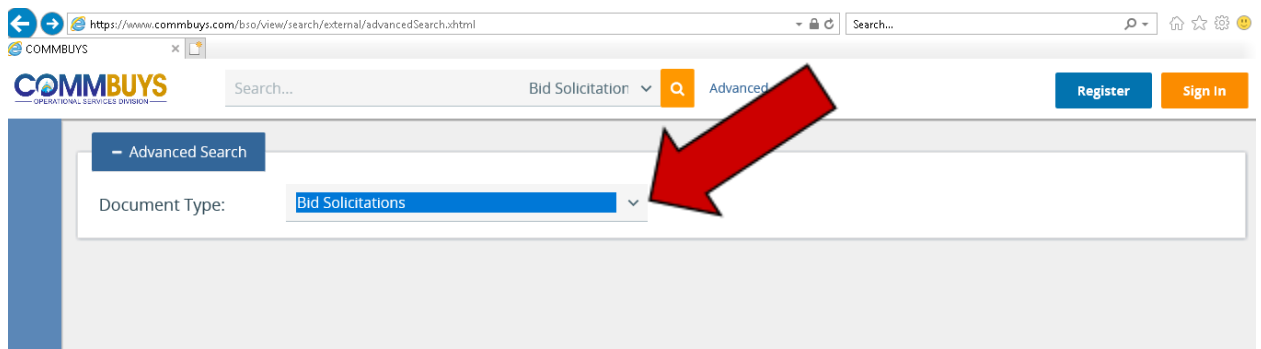

You will be added to the list of bidders that have obtained this IFB and will be notified of any and all changes to the bid documents. If you were logged into your Commbuys user account, you have automatically been added to the list of plan holders.

Instructions to obtain bid documents from Commbuys

1. Go to www.commbuys.com
2. At the top of the screen, click on the advanced search option



3. On the Advanced Search page, click the dropdown box and select bid solicitations.



4. In the Description Box type the project number: DFW-2026-028 OR enter the Commbuys bid number 121727 in the Bid Solicitation # field.
5. The bid results will be displayed. Click on the blue bid solicitation # to obtain the bid documents.
