

Digital Evidence Forensics Internship (DEFI) for Veterans & Service Members Application

Thank you for your interest in applying for the Attorney General's Digital Evidence Forensics Internship.

The Massachusetts Attorney General's Office established this opportunity as a pilot program, in partnership with three community colleges, to expand employment opportunities for veterans and service members interested in the emerging field of Digital Evidence Forensics.

This internship is being offered to students who are veterans or service members currently enrolled at Bristol, Bunker Hill, and Middlesex Community Colleges' Digital Evidence Forensics certificate and/or Associate's degree programs. The name of the program varies by college, and may be referred to as: cyber forensics, computer forensics or digital evidence forensics. This internship places eligible students in state forensics labs to gain hands-on experience in the field of digital evidence forensics. The internship is **unpaid** and there is no special funding for this internship. **If interested**, **please apply immediately as spots may be limited**.

Eligibility for internship:

- Current enrollment in a Digital Evidence Forensics certificate or Associate's Degree program at Bunker Hill, Bristol, or Middlesex Community College;
- Veteran or Service Member;
- Satisfactory completion of introductory coursework in Digital Evidence Forensics; and
- Completion of the application form in its entirety, including attaching the appropriate required supporting documents.
- Please note:
 - Completion of the application does not guarantee placement in a digital forensics lab;
 - Participating law enforcement labs may require additional steps such as a personal interview, as well as a criminal background check and a reference check; and
 - Following acceptance into the internship program, you will be asked to provide an official copy of your transcript if not previously submitted.

- Proof of Military Status: DD Form 214 for veterans; copy of valid Military ID for active military personnel.
