## BabySteps

The BabySteps Savings Plan (BabySteps) is a program that jump-starts Massachusetts families into saving for future education, vocational, and apprenticeship costs. When you enroll your child in a MEFA U.Fund 529 account within a year of their birth or adoption, you will receive a free \$50 deposit into your child's account from the Massachusetts State Treasurer's Office of Economic Empowerment.

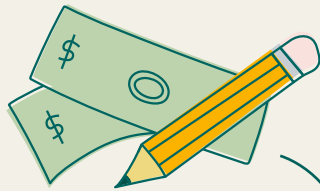
