Many OSHA regulations require employee safety training for the equipment they use and tasks they perform.

The OSHA 10 Training Card is not required for municipal employees because the OSHA 10 Class is a general overview and does not cover all of the mandatory training that is required by OSHA regulations. Training efforts should be focused on specific hazards in the workplace, such as: trench; confined space; ladders; chainsaws; woodchippers; excavators; lockout tagout.
