

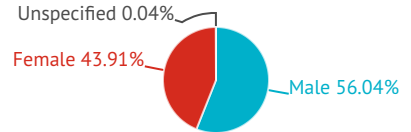
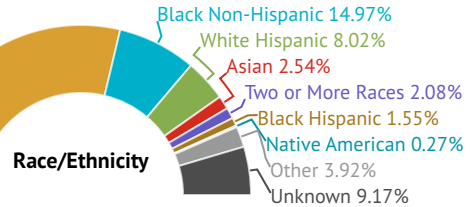
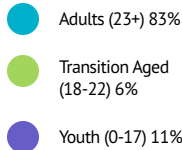
Fiscal Year 2023 - HIGHLIGHTS

The Massachusetts Department of Mental Health (DMH) promotes mental health through early intervention, treatment, education, policy and regulation so that all residents of the Commonwealth may live full and productive lives. The Department also establishes standards to ensure effective and culturally competent care to promote recovery. The Department sets policy, protects human rights and supports mental health training and research. This critical mission is accomplished by working in partnership with other state agencies, individuals, families, providers and communities.

INDIVIDUALS SERVED BY DMH

The DMH serves individuals within the Commonwealth with the most significant and persistent mental illness.

27,339 individuals (21,589 adults) were served in FY23
6,713 individuals received case management.

LIVING AND WORKING IN THE COMMUNITY



10,254 individuals received ACCS in FY23
36 ACCS Programs
17 ACCS Providers

242 individuals moved from inpatient continuing care to ACCS in FY23.

88% of individuals receiving ACCS services were able to remain living in the community during FY23.

HOUSING

- **\$23.3M** in DMH Rental Subsidy Program (DMHRSP) funds were spent in FY23. These funds leased housing units in the community for **2,254** individuals served.
- **96** individuals moved from Supervised Group Living to the DMH Rental Subsidy Program during FY23
- **1,120** Individuals were enrolled in homeless support services through the DMH Homeless Outreach and Engagement Services.

EMPLOYMENT

- **371** ACCS enrollees found work through DMH's partnership with the Massachusetts Rehabilitation Commission (MRC).
- The average individual worked **21 hours per week**.
- **47** individuals were enrolled in job driven trainings in FY23

LICENSING

65 acute psychiatric inpatient hospitals or units were licensed by DMH by the end of FY23, creating a total of **3,139** beds

FORENSIC SERVICES



9,851 Individuals were referred to DMH court clinics by the district, municipal, juvenile and Superior Courts.



116 Jail Diversion (JDP) grants were awarded to police departments and partner organizations (89 police departments)



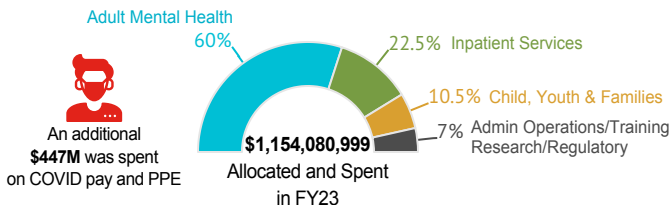
