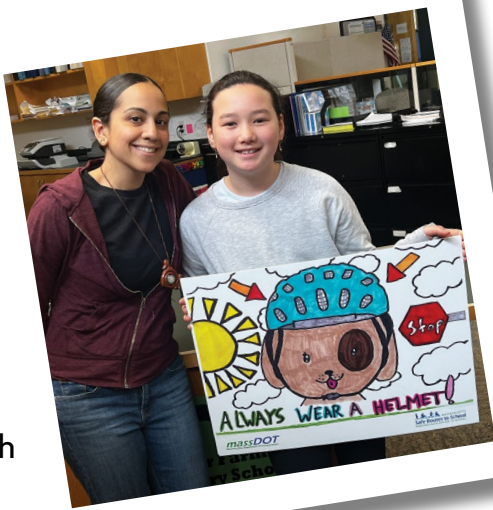
Students make their trip to school safer by designing yard signs for this annual contest.
