DECISION

MOKRO, CORP. DBA BROTHER'S PIZZA II

Mokro, Corp. dba Brother's Pizza II (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, August 14, 2012, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05(2), to wit: c.138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Doyle's Compliance Check Field Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Investigator Doyle's Compliance Check Field Report dated May 4, 2012; and
2. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts.

FACTS


1. On Friday, May 4, 2012 at approximately 8:46 p.m., Investigators Bailey and Doyle conducted an investigation of the business operation of Mokro, Corp. dba Brother's Pizza II.
2. An underage operative working with investigators purchased an alcoholic beverage, a bottle of Bud Light beer for two dollars and fifty cents (\$2.50). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2), to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, §34. As the licensee has had no previous violations, the Commission issues a **WARNING**.


