

Project Location - Resurfacing and Related Work on Route 110 - Lowell, Dracut, Methuen







Project Scope

Reliability

- resurface 6.3 miles of Route 110 in Lowell, Dracut, and Methuen.
- reconstruct a 5-ft sidewalk along the north side of the entire corridor, along with ADA compliant pedestrian ramps.

<u>Destination Connectivity</u>

- Install buffered bike lanes with sinusoidal rumble strips & flex posts at targeted locations Safety
- Install countermeasures/improvements to help reduce operating speeds, observed to be more than posted/regulatory speed (primarily 45 mph), and seen as contributing factor in corridor crash history
- speed management elements including centerline and shoulder rumble strips, chevron signage at horizontal curves, speed feedback signs, and median islands at known potential conflict areas
- A speed zoning study will be conducted at the end of construction with the goal of a permanent reduction in the
 posted speed limit.



Construction Management Approach


Purpose & Need

- Pavement maintenance and resurfacing along with improvements to pedestrian and bicycle facilities along the corridor.
- Address safety concerns due to high operating speeds.

Construction Management Approach

- Work will be done using one 8-hour shift per day, 5 days a week, between the hours of 7:00 am and 3:30 pm.
- Night work for milling and paving operations will be scheduled for Sunday-Thursday evenings, 9:00pm through 5:00am based on coordination with the local communities.
- Construction will take approximately two (2) years to complete.











Questions from Capital Programs Committee

Q1 - With these improvements, is there a reduction in travel lane width?

Yes, travel lanes will be reduced to 11 feet from 12.5 feet. The reduced width will encourage lower speeds while also created space for the bike facility and buffer.

Q2 - What is the District's experience with maintaining the installation of flex posts? Will delineators be taken out in wintertime?

Flex posts are will be used at targeted locations to separate the bicycle facility. Maintenance needs related to flex posts include repair/replacement from vehicle collisions and increased effort in sweeping and snow/ice operations

Q3 - What is current speed limit on the roadway and the target speeds after improvements? Can you speak to crash data and potential hot spots you're hoping address?

The posted/regulatory speed limit for most of the project area is 45 miles per hour (mph) and drops to 35 mph at the western extents of the project adjacent to the Lowell/Dracut town line. There were 6 locations along the corridor where operating speed data was collected. The 85th percentile speed ranged between 47-50 in the 45 mph zone and 34-45 in the 35 mph zone. There have been a number of crashes along the corridor in recent years. Improving safety is a project goal with the installation of speed countermeasures proven to encourage safer operating speeds and ultimately reduce crashes.

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this Staff Summary is to request that the Board of Directors authorize and approve the Secretary/CEO, or her designee, to execute MassDOT Contract No. 128031 titled Resurfacing and Related Work on Route 110, with , PJ Albert, Inc. for \$15,447,156.43 for a total duration, not to exceed, 971 days from Notice to Proceed (NTP).

DISCUSSION:

Improvements will consist of mill and overlay of Route 110 from the area of 333 First Street Blvd in Lowell to the intersection of Riverside Drive in Methuen. In addition to pavement resurfacing, the project will consist of sidewalk reconstruction along the north side of the 6.3-mile corridor with ADA compliant pedestrian curb ramps at all side streets and driveways. The roadway will include buffered bike lanes with flex posts proposed in isolated areas at some intersections, as well as proposed median islands at selected locations to assist with traffic calming and speed management. Sinusoidal rumble strips are proposed along the center line and along shoulder lines. The drainage system will be adjusted to account for any changes in curb line and to ensure catch basins are located at low points. This project includes updated signage and striping along the entire corridor as well as the addition of speed feedback signs and a "traffic entering when flashing" sign at the Wheeler Street approach. A work zone speed limit is proposed and a speed zoning study will be completed at the end of the construction period with the goal to reduce the posted speed limit.

PROCUREMENT:

On September 7, 2024, the Highway Division advertised the contract for bids. On December 17, 2024, the Highway Division opened bids for this contract and four (4) bids were received. PJ Albert Inc. was the lowest qualified and eligible bidder with a price of \$15,447,156.43. The bids were reviewed by engineers in the Construction and Construction Contracts Sections. The Highway Division has accepted the bid submitted by PJ Albert. Inc, which at \$15,447,156.43 is 10.5% lower than the Office Estimate of \$17,260,181.00. 

The notice must take the form of an affidavit sworn to by the owners of the firm before a person who is authorized by state law to administer oaths or of an un-sworn declaration executed under penalty of perjury of the laws of the United States. You must provide the written notification within 30 days of the occurrence of the change. If you fail to make timely notification of such a change, you will be deemed to have failed to cooperate under 49 CFR 26.109(c).

To renew your firm's DBE certification and if it continues to meet the applicable criteria, on or before your firm's certification anniversary date of July 10, 2025, and each year thereafter, please send the MassUCP the following documents:

- (1) Declaration of Eligibility (DOE) (will be sent with reminder letter)
- (2) A <u>signed</u> copy of your company's and all of its affiliates', U.S. Tax Returns including all schedules and attachments for the year(s) indicated.
- (3) A signed copy of your personal tax returns for year(s) indicated.
- (4) If a sole proprietor, a signed copy of your Schedule C. for year(s) indicated.
- (5) A <u>statement</u> of the <u>number only</u> of full- and part-time employees (including owner) for each year indicated.

If you have changed your company name or address, please notify Ms. Nedra D. White, in writing on the company's letterhead in order to update your state vendor file.

MassUCP reserves the right to monitor, perform random spot checks, re-evaluate the firm or revoke the firm's certification if it no longer meets the certification criteria.
