4. Old Business

a. Fire Mobilization Annex

Discussed the functions of Technical Rescue in the Fire Mobilization Annex. Chief Mansfield states this was presented at the Fire Mobilization Committee Meeting. The document will be edited to include all needs and moved forward to the Mobilization Committee to include all the needs. Open to any edits for improvement.

b. Discussion on Subcommittees

• **Policy/SOG** met a few weeks ago to introduce the group and plan to use the Hazmat forms for a standard form to use on all SOGs. The subcommittee will begin with the safety

officer position to begin with.

- **Membership** minutes from the meeting were shared. Director DiGregorio discussed the highlights of the meeting. An introduction to discuss what the membership committee will be responsible for.
- **Training** meeting was an introduction. A lot of the training will correlate with the Membership meeting.
- Equipment next meeting is May 3rd at 10am. No responses received for amphibious vehicles. The expense, housing, and additional training are too costly at this time.

Director DiGregorio recognized Linda Crowley for putting the meetings postings together and hosting the meetings.

Peter Jerusik discusses the webpage and how it now includes the Steering Committees on the website. The Western Regional Steering Committee does not have the resources to hold a WebEx meeting. The meetings are required to follow open meeting law. Can we support them if they support the Technical Rescue group? There will be a discussion with the Marshal. At the time we do not have the capacity to assist administratively. Leave as an open item for the next meeting.

a. Discussion the Concept of Operations.

The membership, equipment, training, and policy/SOG subcommittees' work will be documented in a book. Each subcommittee is a chapter in the book to summarize Statewide Technical Rescue. The book will create the foundation for the funding needs. Legislation will be included in the book. Have a minimum across the board for each region.

b. FFE Field Force Extrication.

Applications are due to OGR for funding this month on April 9th. State share funding is in May. Suggested having OGR attend the next meeting and provide a short presentation on funding. Have Kevin Stanton attend the meeting the end of April.

David DiGregorio shares the National USAR Urban Search and Rescue code of conduct. He will send it to the Policy/SOG Chair, Russel Lewis to incorporate into the next policy meeting.
