The Registry of Motor Vehicles will not provide email or phone number information to the public.

- **B1:** Enter your last name. If you are applying for a REAL ID, you must enter your full legal name.
- **B2:** Enter your first name.
- **B3:** Enter your middle name. Leave it blank if you do not have a middle name.

- **B4:** Enter suffix, if applicable. For example, Sr., Jr., I, II, III, etc.
- **B5:** Enter your current Massachusetts learner's permit, driver's license, or ID card number, if applicable. Leave it blank if you have never been issued a credential in Massachusetts.
- **B6:** Enter your date of birth. Enter 2 numbers for month, enter 2 numbers for day, and enter 4 numbers for year of birth.
- **B7:** Enter your complete social security number if one has been issued to you.
- **B8:** If you do not have an SSN, you will need an SSA Denial Notice and foreign passport for REAL IDs or ID Cards. You may apply for a Standard Learner's Permit or Driver's License using an SSA Denial Notice OR an Affidavit of No SSN with an unexpired foreign passport or consular ID. Select foreign passport or consular ID, if providing, and enter the document number and country.
- **B9:** Check the box if you ever had a Massachusetts permit, license, ID, or vehicle registration. If yes, provide the name it was under and the number (if known). Leave it blank if you have never been issued a Massachusetts permit, license, ID, or vehicle registration.
- **B10:** Enter the street address, apartment or unit number (if applicable), city, state, and zip code of where you reside.
- **B11:** Select the box if your mailing and residential address is the same. If your mailing address is different, enter the street address, apartment or unit number (if applicable), city, state, and zip code of your mailing address.
- **B12:** Enter your email address. This will be used for confirmation emails or if the RMV needs to contact you for any reason.
- **B13:** If you would like to provide your phone number, select phone type cell, home, or work.
- **B14:** Enter your complete phone number, if applicable.
- **B15:** Enter emergency contact email address, if applicable.
- **B16:** Enter the first and last name of emergency contact, if applicable.
- **B17:** Select emergency contact phone type cell, home, or work, if applicable.
- **B18:** Enter emergency contact phone number, if applicable.

- D3: Enter your height (in feet and inches) that will display on your RMV record and credential.
- **D4:** Select Yes or No if you would like to be (or continue to be) an Organ and Tissue Donor. For more information on organ and tissue donation, visit NEDS.org.
- **D5:** Select Yes or No if you would like to donate \$2 to the Organ and Tissue Donor Registration Fund (for renewal and replacement transactions only).
- **D6:** Check the appropriate box if you are an active duty member of the military or a veteran.
- **D7:** If you are a veteran of the U.S. Armed Forces, check the box if you want the word "Veteran" printed on your credential.
- **D8:** Enter the military branch you served in.

If you do not meet all of the above conditions, you will not be registered to vote.
If you are at least age 16 at the time of application, you will be pre-registered to vote. You will become registered and eligible to vote when you turn 18. If you are under age 16, you will not be pre-registered.

To be eligible for voter registration, you must be:

- A Massachusetts resident, and
- At least 16 years old, and
- Not under guardianship that prohibits registering to vote, and
- Not temporarily or permanently disqualified by law from voting, and
- Not currently incarcerated for a felony conviction.

If you do not meet all the above conditions, you will not be registered to vote.

If you are at least age 16 at the time of application, you will be pre-registered to vote. You will become registered and eligible to vote when you turn 18. If you are under age 16, you will not be pre-registered.

The office at which you submit your registration is confidential and will only be used for voter registration purposes.

When you sign the application, you are affirming the following (under the penalty of perjury):

I hereby swear (affirm) that I am the person named above, the above information is true, and that I consider the residential address provided to be my home. I understand that if I do not meet one or more of the above conditions, I must opt out of registering to vote when I receive the automatic voter registration mailing.

Penalty for illegal voter registration: Fine of not more than \$10,000 or imprisonment for not more than five years or both (M.G.L., Chap. 56, Section 8).
