Shan Li described the new RFS changes. Currently projects \$800,000 and above go via RFS to the DSC and the new threshold will be \$1,000,000 for RFS to go through DSC. This aligns with the current DCAMM's DSC regulations. There will be only minor changes to the RFS template. There will also be a new house doctor RFS to add an additional 20 house doctor architects and 10 engineers. EOHLC has a 13 week backup on our current house doctor projects. The house doctor light program goes through the Designer Network Program. Projects 25K to 100K house doctor light program.

A motion was made for adjournment at 2:58. Garrick Goldenberg moved, and Gabe Ciccariello seconded.
