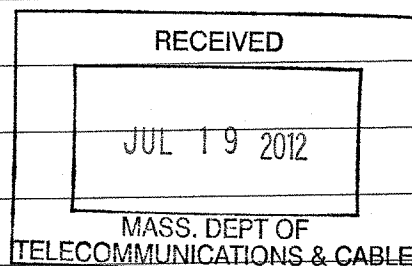

RE: Prison Telephone Services

To whom it may concern

I am currently an inmate at the Plymouth County Correctional Facility. The phones for me is a high price luxury that I can only afford a couple of phone calls during a months time, due to the excessive cost of making a call. For example, the exuberant connection fee, the high per minute rate, and the frequently dropped calls (all of my call are made to land lines and not cell phones) adding to more connection fees. I do not come from a family of great wealth, so the money I do receive from them (about \$40 a month) I choose to put on my canteen and not on my phone account, again due to the high cost and the unreliability of the service. If the cost of the phone service would be

decreased to a more reasonable one, I along with countless other inmates might be able to make more phone calls, (if not there first call) to our love ones and families.

I am very fortunate to get visits every week, but to some the phones are the only way some inmates have to communicate with the outside world. And with the phone service's prices so high that outlet might not be a choice for some.

So please lower the rates of the phone services, so that inmates like myself and others can talk with our love ones and hear there loving voices.
