MOTION OF COMCAST PHONE OF MASSACHUSETTS, INC. FOR LEAVE FOR LATE FILING OF PETITION TO INTERVENE

Pursuant to 220 C.M.R. 1.04(5)(a) and the June 28, 2013 Hearing Officer Ruling (“Ruling”) issued by the Department of Telecommunications and Cable (“Department”), Comcast Phone of Massachusetts, Inc. (“Comcast”), on behalf of itself and its voice affiliates, hereby moves for leave for the late filing of its petition to intervene in D.T.C. Docket No. 13-6.

As grounds for this motion, Comcast states that due to the confidential nature of the commercial agreement at issue, additional time was necessary to formulate a determination on whether, and to what extent, Comcast would file a petition to intervene. Moreover, Comcast states that the time that has elapsed between today and the date set forth in the Ruling is minimal, and that such additional time was reasonable in light of the above-stated circumstances.

Comcast further states that neither the Department nor any other party to this matter is or will be prejudiced by the granting of this motion.

GRANT its motion for leave for late filing of its petition to intervene.
