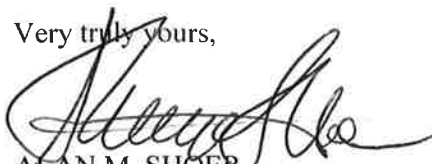

Pursuant to MA General Laws Chapter 30A Section 10 and 220 CMR 1.03, Cox Rhode Island Telcom LLC and Charter Fiberline MA-CCO, LLC ("Cox and Charter") hereby move that the Department authorize Cox and Charter to participate in these proceedings for the limited purpose of providing written comments and position statements in response to the important questions raised in this investigation, concerning whether an Agreement Entered into by Verizon New England, Inc., d/b/a Verizon Massachusetts is an "Interconnection Agreement" under 47 U.S.C. § 251 such that the Agreement must be filed with the Department for approval in accordance with 47 U.S.C. § 252.

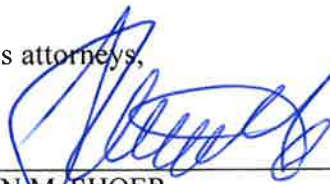
Cox and Charter are both competitive telecommunications providers; duly registered with the Massachusetts Department of Telecommunications and Cable to provide competitive telecommunication services to customers in Massachusetts. This dispute and this investigation concern important regulatory concerns of first impression to the telecommunications industry with implications to companies that interconnect with Verizon. Both Cox and Charter have interconnection arrangements with Verizon. This investigation therefore could have significant impact to Cox and Charter in Massachusetts.

For these reasons, Cox and Charter request that the Department allow these companies to participate in this investigation. Cox and Charter expect to provided their positions on the important questions raised in this investigation, and to assist the Department as it decides this matter, through conferences, technical sessions, hearings, briefs and filing any written responses necessary to motions or filings brought by a party or in response to rulings by the DTC.
