

# 'I'm sorry,' killer tells family of slain pizza delivery man

stabbed 16 times while making
a delivery for Domino's, where
he had recently started working. His killers ran off with the
two pizzas they had ordered,
cash they fished from Nova's
pockets, and his green Subaru.

"He's never going to call me
back," Michelle Romero, now
24 and a teacher, told a packed
Suffolk courtroom where her
father's killers were to be senteneed. Her sister stood next to
her, rubbing her shoulder and
cyring, while Michelle Romero
struggled through sobs to tell
the court what she had lost.

"I'll never have the opportunity to hear my dad's voice
again," she said. "I will never
get to dance with him again.
Papi didn't get to see me gradute college. He won't be there
for my wedding. He won't get
to be the grandfather of my

for my wedding. He won't get to be the grandfather of my children, among so many events in my life."

Less than 20 feet away sat the three people convicted in Nova's killing — Alexander Gallett, 22; Yamiley Mathurin, 21, and Michel St. Jean, 24; Gallett and St. Jean kept their heads down as Mathurin looked at the twins.

"The man who was tortured that night was not just a delivery man." Romero said. "He was my dad. He was my little old man. Mi viejito."

The twins had been in court Less than 20 feet away sat

every day of the trial, listening to gruesome testimony about their father's final moments. The two-week trial culminated Tuesday in guilty verducts of first-degree murder for St. Jean and Gallett. Mathurin pleaded guilty to manslaughter, armed robbery, and breaking and entering before the trial began. On Wednesday, St. Jean and Gallett received required sentences of life in prison without parole, Mathurin received a sentence of 17 to 20 years.

At the time of his death, Nova had been working two part-time jobs, delivering D'Angelo's sandwiches by day and pizzas by night. In addition to fathering the twins with his longtime companion, Marilyn Pimentel, Nova also helped Pimentel rises two children. Pimentel raise two children

Pimentel raise two children from a previous relationship as if they were his own.

Nova dreamed of a retirement spent under a mango tree in the Dominican Republic, but he kept working to help his twins through college.

In court Wednesday, his daughters, both now teachers, had to frequently stop to compose themselves while reading their statements.

"I didn't want this trial,"
Gallett said softly, his head
bowed. "I just hope [my sentence] brings you peace and a
little closure."

Many of Nova's family members, who filled two rows in the courtroom, gasped and wept loudly. Ladislao Perez, Nova's brother-in-law, said after the sentencing that the apology

took him aback.

"Hearing that boy apologize

took him aback.

"Hearing that by apologize shows he has a heart, he has a conscience," Perez. 47, said "We're not ones to judge. That's why we have laws in this country. May God protect him. Only God can forgive him:

Suffolk District Attorney Damie F Conley, who was present during the sentencing, said he was moved by the apology.

"There was a sliver, a glimpse, a bit of daylight of humanity in Mr. Gallett when he asked for forgiveness," he said.

But Conley said he still struggles to understand why Nova was killed. "How do people become this way, especially at a young age?" Conley said "We're not required to prove motive. We never are. But it certainly eats at us. Why did they do such a thing?"
