Investigation by the Department on its Own Motion into Accounting Practices and Recordkeeping of Telecommunications Carriers

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

On June 25, 2018, the Department of Telecommunications and Cable ("Department") opened an investigation into the accounting and recordkeeping practices of telecommunications carriers. This proceeding, docketed as D.T.C. 18-3, is a formal adjudicatory proceeding pursuant to G.L. c. 30A and 207 C.M.R. 1.00. After two rounds of public comment, the Department issued a Notice of Proposed Requirements and Further Request for Comment on May 3, 2022, proposing annual reporting requirements for certain pole owners. Additionally, the Department proposed rules governing the maintenance of financial records related to these filings. The Department seeks comment on these proposals and on which entities should be subject to the proposed requirements. To that end, the Department will hold a public hearing on the Microsoft Teams videoconferencing platform at 10 a.m. on June 14, 2022.
