The Department will hold public and evidentiary hearings in this matter on **July 24, 2018**.

All common carriers identified above are directed to attend the aforementioned evidentiary hearing and provide to the Department in writing the following information by **Monday July 16, 2018**:

1. Did the company file the annual return for the relevant calendar year(s)? If so, provide a copy of the annual return(s) and documentation of the filing(s). If not, explain why the company did not file the annual return(s), and state whether the failure to file is reasonable. If the failure to file is stated as reasonable, explain why.
2. Did the company provide telecommunications services in Massachusetts during the relevant calendar year(s)?
3. If applicable, state whether the Secretary of the Commonwealth has reinstated the company's authority to do business within the Commonwealth.
4. If applicable, provide the current company address, contact information, and an amended tariff and Statement of Business Operations reflecting that change.

If any common carrier fails to attend the evidentiary hearing or timely provide the Department with the information requested above, the Department may make adverse findings of fact, i.e. that the company failed to file its annual return(s). Consequently, the Department may order corrective action, including: cancelling the company's registration and intrastate tariff(s) on file with Department, thus preventing the company from operating and/or providing telecommunications services within the Commonwealth; assessing statutory forfeitures; and referring the matter to the Attorney General for enforcement.

This proceeding has been docketed under the generic docket number, D.T.C. 18-AR, with a sequential number for each individual case, D.T.C. 18-AR-1 through D.T.C. 18-AR-40, and is a formal adjudicatory proceeding conducted under G.L. c. 30A and 207 C.M.R. § 1.00.

The Department will accept public comment on the above-captioned matter at the public hearing. The Department will also accept written public comment from any person until July 16, 2018. In addition, any person who desires to participate formally in this proceeding must file a written petition for leave to intervene or to participate. Written comments and petitions for leave to intervene should be directed to Shonda D. Petitions for leave to intervene must satisfy the substantive requirements of 207 C.M.R. § 1.03. The text of the email or written petition must specify: (1) the complete docket number; (2) the name of the person submitting the filing; (3) that person's title, if any; and (4) a brief descriptive title of the document (e.g., petition to intervene). The petition should also include the name, title, and telephone number of a person to contact in the event of questions about the filing.
