Enclosed for filing are an original and three (3) copies of Cox's annual FCC Forms 1240 and 1205 for the Town of Holland along with documentation generally explaining the methodologies Cox used in preparing the filings. Also enclosed for your convenience is a Basic Service, Equipment, and Installation Rate Summary reflecting Cox's current and proposed rates scheduled to become effective on June 5, 2019. Cox last adjusted its rates on or about March 11, 2018.

The enclosed current FCC Form 1205 also reflects minor non-substantive differences from the previous Form 1205. These changes are designed to remove certain now superfluous equipment and installation categories that Cox has not used in many years and that were included on previous Form 1205 filings for historical reasons only. For example, Cox removed the categories for "Non Addressable Boxes" and "Digital Installs." These changes are cosmetic only and have no effect on the MPRs calculated on the Form 1205. Cox's New England cable systems have been all-digital for several years; Cox therefore has no Non Addressable Boxes in use, and the distinction for Digital Installs is meaningless for Cox's all-digital systems.


