The report shall include a description of any such expenditure including transaction numbers; transaction dates, vendors, equipment model and serial numbers, price per unit and the name of the EOTSS manager who attested to the purchase." Whereas the effective date of the subject ISA is March 18, 2020, the Executive Office of Technology and Services and Security will file such first quarterly report with State 911 after June 30, 2020, (after the last quarter of FY20 closes).
