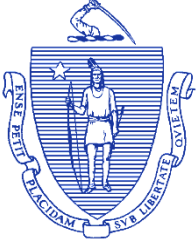

**RESPONSE TO THE FOURTH SET OF INFORMATION REQUESTS
FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF TELECOMMUNICATIONS AND CABLE
BY BOOST SUBSCRIBERCO L.L.C. D/B/A GEN MOBILE**

Pursuant to the Fourth Set of Information Requests from the Department of Telecommunications and Cable (“Department”) for Information to Boost SubscriberCo L.L.C. (“Boost”) dated August 13, 2026 in the above-captioned matter, Boost files this response to Department Requests D.T.C. 4-1 through 4-6. Unless otherwise noted, Robert Yap, Senior Vice President, is the sponsor to the answers to the Department Request and can voice for the truth of the original answers it provides hereunder should there be any relevant change in circumstances.

Requests

- D.T.C. 4-1 Provide Boost’s most recent annual profit and loss statement balance sheet.**
- Boost 4-1 Boost provides the following link to EchoStar Corporation’s (“EchoStar”) Form 10-K for 2025: <https://ir.echostar.com/sec-filings/sec-filing/10-k/0001104659-26-021817>. It is important to note that this data represents financial data that has been consolidated for EchoStar’s various direct and indirect subsidiaries, including Boost.
- D.T.C. 4-2 Provide detail as to what assets were specifically transferred from DISH to Boost and further explain the transfer of “certain assets” that was referenced in the amendment to the petition filed with the Department on November 17, 2025. Provide any formal documentation that accompanied the transfer, including an explanation of the terms and conditions of the transfer.**
- Boost 4-2 In the second half of 2025, EchoStar completed an internal restructuring which resulted in a pro forma transfer whereby DISH Wireless L.L.C. (“DISH”) transferred certain wireless assets (including retail wireless customers, contracts, brands (including the Gen Mobile brand), and related assets) to Boost, pursuant to the terms and conditions of a Contribution and Assignment Agreement.
- D.T.C. 4-3 Provide detail regarding the level of oversight DISH or any affiliate will exercise over Boost, including whether Boost will operate as an independent company or whether DISH or any affiliate will retain authority over Boost’s management decisions.**
- Boost 4-3 Both DISH and Boost are wholly owned, indirect subsidiaries of EchoStar. Boost is ultimately owned and controlled by EchoStar, which also owns and controls DISH Wireless. This internal reorganization did not result in a change in control nor any change in the personnel providing oversight due to the transaction. In the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, Boost will operate wholly independently of DISH Wireless.
- D.T.C. 4-4 Identify any debts Boost will assume as a result of the DISH bankruptcy filed in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of Texas on June 30, 2026.**
- Boost 4-4 Boost is not a Debtor in the DISH bankruptcy filing and is not assuming any debts as a result of such filing.
- D.T.C. 4-5 Elaborate whether the above referenced DISH bankruptcy is expected to have any impact on Boost’s financial, operational, or technical ability to provide reliable Lifeline service to eligible Massachusetts households, including any effects on service continuity, customer support, network access or Boost’s ability to meet its obligations.**
- Boost 4-5 The above-referenced DISH bankruptcy is not expected to have any impact on Boost’s financial, operational, or technical ability to provide reliable Lifeline service to eligible Massachusetts households. Boost is not a Debtor in the DISH bankruptcy filing.
- D.T.C. 4-6 Provide a list of states in which Boost has been approved as an ETC and the date of any such approval.**
- Boost 4-6 At the time of this filing, Boost has been approved as an ETC in New Mexico, South Carolina, and West Virginia.
