
No party has intervened in this case and no one has responded to the Department’s Request for Public Comment. The only substantive filings in the docket are Verizon’s Petition, the Direct Testimony of Paul B. Vasington, the Department’s three sets of information requests, and Verizon’s responses to those requests. Verizon respectfully submits that the evidence conclusively demonstrates that it is a nondominant carrier in the Massachusetts intra-LATA market and that the Verizon Alternative Regulation Plan, the retail Service Quality Plan and the Massachusetts Competitive Profile should be retired.
