


Why do you need a Certificate of Compliance?

You must submit the Certificate of Compliance from the Massachusetts Department of Unemployment with your Dairy Tax Application to receive the tax credit.

The following slides will detail the step-by-step process of requesting a Certificate of Compliance whether your farm is registered with the DUA or not.


If you are registered with DUA, you can obtain a certificate of compliance by logging into your <u>Unemployment Services for Employers Account.</u>

1. Click on Additional Services





- 2. Scroll down to Compliance section
- 3. Click Request Certificate of Compliance



9. If you have an account but receive the below message that you are not eligible for a Certificate of Compliance, you must answer YES to the question, "Do you need a certificate of compliance, but do not currently have Massachusetts payroll?"



This request is subject to DUA review. Staff will review your request and notify you of a decision.



Agricultural

• An agricultural employer becomes liable for UI contributions once either of the following conditions have occurred: total cash wages of \$40,000 or more in any calendar quarter have been paid or 10 or more individuals were employed on any day in each of 20 weeks in a calendar year


12. Provide a reason for requesting the certificate of compliance, Click Next



- Wage information and other confidential UC information may be requested and utilized for other governmental purposes, including, but not limited to, verification of an individual's eligibility for other government programs.
