DECISION

TONG V. HUNYNH, MINH, THOI & LUC NGUYEN DBA KWIK STOPS

Tong V. Hunynh, Minh, Thoi & Luc Nguyen dba Kwik Stops (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, December 3, 2013, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2)- Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: c. 138, §34 Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Kujawski's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts; and
2. Investigator Kujawski's Investigative Report dated June 24, 2013.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

FACTS

1. On Monday, June 24, 2013, at approximately 5:52 p.m., Investigators Keefe and Kujawski conducted an investigation of the business operation of Tong V. Hunynh, Minh, Thoi & Luc Nguyen dba Kwik Stops.
2. An underage operative, working with investigators, purchased an alcoholic beverage, a can of Budweiser Light beer for two dollars and fifty cents (\$2.50). The underage operative was not asked for identification.



Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) - Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: c. 138, §34 Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. As the licensee has not had any violation in more than ten (10) years, the Commission issues a **WARNING**.
