DECISION

J & S BLUE, INC. DBA SINNIS PUB **6 CHASE AVENUE DUDLEY, MA 01571** LICENSE#: 029600023 VIOLATION DATE: 06/24/2013 HEARD: 12/03/2013

J & S Blue, Inc. dba Sinnis Pub (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, December 3, 2013, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2)- Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: c. 138, §34 Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twentyone (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Kujawski's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

- 1. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts; and
- 2. Investigator Kujawski's Investigative Report dated June 24, 2013.

FACTS

- 1. On Monday, June 24, 2013, at approximately 5:37 p.m., Investigators Keefe and Kujawski conducted an investigation of the business operation of J & S Blue, Inc. dba Sinnís Pub.
- 2. An underage operative, working with investigators, purchased an alcoholic beverage, a bottle of Budweiser Light beer for three dollars (\$3.00). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) - Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: e. 138, 34 - Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. As the licensee has been in business for more than ten (10) years, and has not had any previous violations, the Commission issues a **WARNING**.
