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Electronic-Filing Notice

On September 8, 2017, the Department of Telecommunications and Cable (“Department”) promulgated 207 C.M.R. 1.00, permitting electronic filing of most documents.¹ Filers may also continue to file with the Department in hardcopy in addition to, or in lieu of electronic filing. A filer seeking to file electronically shall submit the filing as an email attachment to dtc.efiling@mass.gov. The Department may reject any attempted electronic filing not sent as an email attachment to dtc.efiling@mass.gov. Electronic filers shall continue to meet the service requirements of 207 C.M.R. § 1.05. Service lists for docketed proceedings are available upon request.

Notarized documents containing a handwritten signature and physical seal may be submitted for electronic filing. Filers shall submit a scanned copy of the notarized document to dtc.efiling@mass.gov. The Department may require the filer to produce the original paper document. The filer shall retain the original for future production, if necessary, for a period of three years after filing, or any longer period as may be required by applicable law.
