# Introduction

- **The Commonwealth is planning to move the medical and psychiatric services of the Lemuel Shattuck Hospital (LSH) from its campus in Jamaica Plain built in 1954 to the ENP, previously owned by Boston Medical Center, in the South End. The move is planned for 2024.**
- **The hospital's mission is to deliver compassionate medical, surgical and psychiatric care to patients requiring multi-disciplinary treatment and support to promote their health, well-being, rehabilitation and recovery. The hospital strives to continuously improve the quality of life for its patients through the delivery of collaborative treatment and patient-focused care.**
- **Shattuck Hospital has a longstanding commitment to the economically, racially and culturally diverse patients and communities that it serves.**
- **The hospital is operated by the Massachusetts Department of Public Health (DPH) in conjunction with the Department of Mental Health (DMH) and the Department of Correction (DOC).**

# Introduction

- **LSH currently provides 260 inpatient beds along with outpatient services largely provided for DOC and Houses of Corrections (HOCs) patients (primary care, orthopedics, surgery, radiology, diagnostics, etc.). These hospital services will be relocated to the ENP in 2024**
- **270 Inpatient bed units planned for the ENP location:**
  - 124 inpatient medical/surgical beds - Operated by DPH
  - 115 inpatient psychiatric beds - Operated by DMH
  - 31 medical/surgical beds - Dedicated to DOC/HOC patients
- **Private vendor provided services NOT from the Shattuck Jamaica Plain campus to the ENP include:**
  - Residential treatment programs
  - Pine Street shelter
  - Methadone clinic

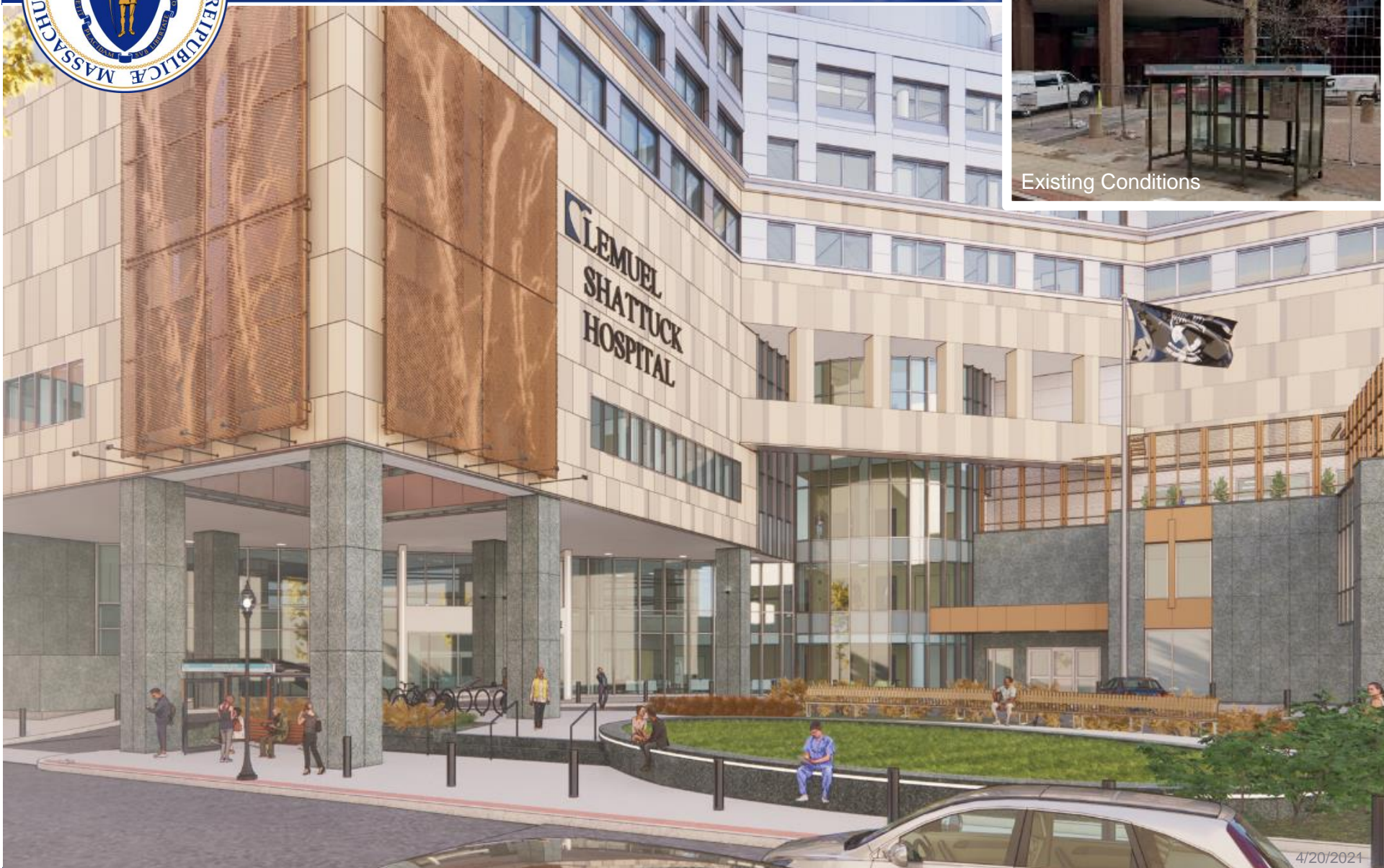

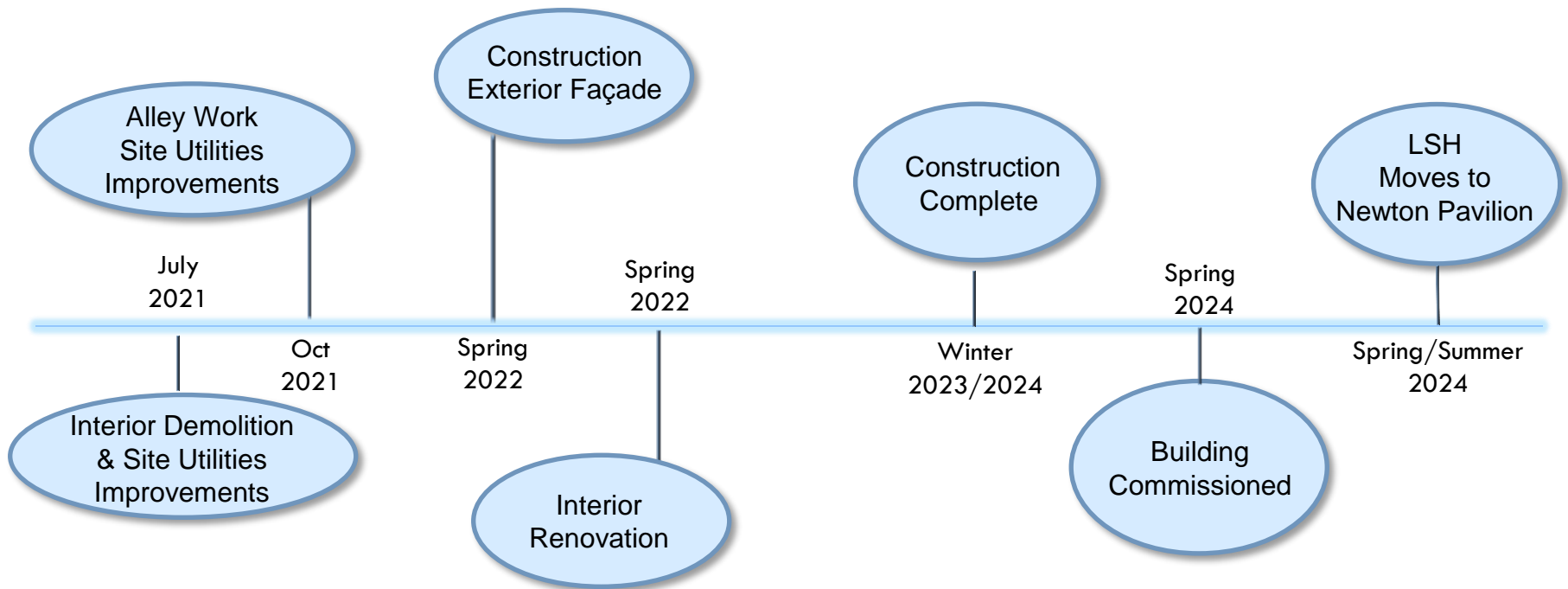
