Support for College

EEC provides financial assistance towards **college certificates and degrees** at eligible Massachusetts colleges and universities.

You are eligible to apply for financial assistance if you work, or plan to begin working at, an EEC licensed or funded:

- Family Child Care (FCC)
- Center-based program
- After School/Out-of-School Time (ASOST) program
- Residential Placement program
- Contracted Family Child Care (FCC) System

How to start?

Get Started with Career Pathways

- 1. Choose the community college that is closest to where you live or work. Colleges will prioritize students in their regional area.
 - If you've already taken classes at a community college, return to that college.
 - If you need classes in a language other than English, select a college that offers the language you need.
- 2. Send an email to the Career Pathways Grant Coordinator at the community college of your choice.
- 3. There will be several steps to take for course registration. Watch your email for a reply from the Grant Coordinator (please check your email regularly)

Have your high school diploma and/or any previous college transcripts available upon request from the Grant Coordinator to determine eligibility for enrollment and to identify course selection.

Early Childhood Education(ECE) Scholarship

Get Started with the ECE Scholarship

Action Steps:

Confirm eligibility requirements

- Complete FAFSA and ECE Scholarship application
- Apply to the college of your choice (two- or four- year institution)
- Attend to emails and messages from the college and MA Office of Student Financial Assistance (OSFA)

Eligibility Requirements

•Physically reside in Massachusetts for at least one year, as of the start of the enrolled term, with an intent to remain in Massachusetts consistent with Board of Higher Education policy; and

•Have approved eligibility status as a "High School Completer,"* per the Massachusetts tuition equity law,** or be a U.S. Citizen, permanent legal resident, or noncitizen eligible under Title IV regulations.

•Have applied for financial aid, using the standard Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or a FAFSA equivalent application authorized by the Department of Higher Education.

•Not be in default of any federal or state Student Loans for attendance at any institution or owe a refund for any previous financial aid received.

Enroll, as a matriculated student, in an approved college certificate or degree program, full or part-time, in an eligible institution.
 Be employed as an educator or provider in an early education and care program (FCC, center-based, after/out-of-school time, residential placement or contracted FCC system) that is licensed or funded by the Massachusetts Department of Early Education and Care (EEC).

OR

Be considered a "prospective student" which is defined as unemployed or not employed as an early education and care provider at a facility or program, licensed or funded by the Department of Early Education and Care, but plan to enroll in an approved course of study as defined in the eligibility requirements of the ECE Scholarship.

 Prospective students must demonstrate they are seeking employment with an early education and care provider in the commonwealth and will have one year to secure eligible employment.

•Sign an agreement to continue employment as an early childhood educator or provider in Massachusetts upon completing the degree requirement, or repay funds as defined.

•Students must either be pursuing their first bachelor's degree or pursuing a master's degree in an approved program, as defined.

Complete the FAFSA or equivalent

Be sure to complete the **2025-2026** FAFSA

Wait 72 hours (3 days) for FAFSA data to process. You will receive an email from OSFA inviting you to login to your MASSAid portal.

Service Commitment Agreement

I understand that although there are no procedures for repayment if a student fails to complete the above commitments, that as a recipient of the ECE Scholarship there is an expectation that students will continue to be employed in the Early Childhood Education field as an educator or provider in Massachusetts for six months per semester of scholarship receipt, not to exceed a two year maximum commitment upon graduation from an associate's degree program and a four year maximum commitment upon graduation from a bachelor's degree program.

In the event that the fiscal year appropriation is not sufficient to permit a full award to each eligible student, priority consideration will be given to eligible applicants recommended by an individual qualified to speak to their commitment and dedication to the field of early education and care; or members of a socially or economically disadvantaged community as defined by the Department in consultation with the Department of Early Education and Care.

What happens next?

Monitor your email inbox. All information and notifications will be sent via email.
Read emails closely.

>Allow time for DHE and EEC review (3-4 weeks).

If you receive an email that you are "ineligible," you will have 20 days to correct the reason for ineligibility. Instructions will be in the email.

Award amount will remain as "pending" until your school "certifies" that you are enrolled and attending classes- usually at the end of add/drop period.
