Now comes the Plaintiff, Edward Eckert, and respectfully moves this Honorable Court pursuant to Mass R. Civ. P. 12 (c) and Standing Order No. 1-96 for judgment on the pleadings against the Defendants, Massachusetts Civil Service Commission and City of Holyoke.
