EV319 Educator Evaluation Rating District Summary

EV319 provides a summary view of a single district's educator evaluation rating distribution across schools for a single school year. It includes educator evaluation ratings on the overall rating, standards 1-4, and the impact rating. Additionally, the report includes educator PTS and Waiver information, as well as student enrollment information for each school.

The educator population includes those who were required to be evaluated in the June EPIMS collection in the selected school year, and may be filtered by a set of educator employment characteristics. The report includes only evaluations submitted by the selected district during the selected year.

Educator evaluation rating and district employment information is reported by the district of employment.
