Dear Governor Healey:

On behalf of the Massachusetts Office of Business Development (MOBD), we are pleased to submit the Economic Development Incentive Program (EDIP) FY 2023 Annual Report in accordance with Section 3B(c) of Chapter 23A of the Massachusetts General Laws. The Annual Report covers the Economic Assistance Coordinating Council (EACC) and the Economic Development Incentive Program for FY 2023, ending June 30, 2023.

The EDIP continues to be one of the largest job creation incentives in the Commonwealth. In fiscal year 2023, the EACC certified 13 projects to receive EDIPC tax credits amounting to \$8,798,000. These 13 projects will create 978 new jobs, retain 2,365 jobs and represent a \$309 million private investment. The EACC Board also approved 13 projects for local incentives.

In FY 2023, 1 Vacant Storefront District and 7 Vacant Storefront Projects were approved. Together the Certified EDIPC Projects, Local Incentives Only projects and Vacant Storefront projects, came from 30 municipalities, represented 18 manufacturers, and 8 projects are located in Gateway Cities.
