Brief Description of Internship Position:

The EOEEA is seeking an intern to support efforts for the Clean Heat Commission and Clean Heat Task Force by conducting research and providing logistical help as needed.

Description of Duties and Responsibilities:

The Commonwealth will soon convene a Commission on Clean Heat, which will recommend by the end of this year a framework for the Commonwealth to set declining annual emissions cap on heating fuels in the buildings sector. The work of the Commission will be supported by an interagency Task Force on Clean Heat. We are seeking an intern who will provide research and logistical support with stakeholder and public meetings to support this important effort. The intern will be able to hear directly from diverse stakeholders about clean heat concerns, as well as help EEA shape how those concerns are shared, processed, and considered in policy development.

Preferred Knowledge and Skills:

Familiarity with or an interest in greenhouse gas emissions, climate change adaptation, heating fuels, and/or clean heat technologies.

Skills and experience in internet research, literature review, word processing in Microsoft Word, presentation development in Microsoft PowerPoint, and effective oral and written communications.
