Policy: Child Care Financial Assistance Voucher Billing Windows

Effective Date: April 1, 2024

OVERVIEW

In order to better support the financial stability of early education and care providers, the Department of Early Education and Care (EEC) is increasing flexibility in how **voucher payments** are processed for programs that accept child care financial assistance.

As of April 1, 2024, **EEC will support two billing windows each month.** Providers will still only be paid once a month for services provided in the previous month, but they will now have two different windows in which they can get their invoice in by to be paid on time.

APPLICABILITY

This policy applies to all early education and care providers that accept child care financial assistance vouchers.

KEY UPDATES

As of April 1, EEC will support two billing windows each month for **voucher payments**. Providers will still only be paid once a month for services provided in the previous month, but they will now have two different windows in which they can get their invoice in by to be paid on time:

- Window 1: billing due to your <u>Child Care Resource and Referral Agency</u> by 5pm the 9th of the month.
 - o If the 9th falls on a weekend or holiday, the submission date is the prior business day.
- Window 2: billing due to your Child Care Resource and Referral Agency by 5pm the 20th of the month.
 - o If the 20th falls on a weekend or holiday, the submission date is the prior business day.

Providers will receive their voucher payment 5-6 business days after their Child Care Resource and Referral Agency submits the billing information to EEC.
