FINAL NOTICE: SUSPENSION

Dear Eila Gallo:

On February 13, 2023, you entered into a Consent Agreement for SARP Participation ("Agreement") with the Board of Registration in Nursing ("Board"). A copy of the Agreement is enclosed with this letter for your review.

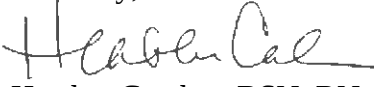
On April 25, 2024, the Board sent a Notice of Violation and Intent to Suspend ("Notice") to your address of record. A copy of the Notice is enclosed. The Notice informed you that you are in violation of the Agreement and listed the facts supporting the determination that you are in violation. The Notice also informed you that the Board intended to exercise its discretion under the Agreement by suspending your nursing license. The Notice informed you that you had a right to a hearing on the limited issue of whether you are in compliance with, or in violation of, the terms of the Agreement. Lastly, the Notice informed you that to claim your right to a hearing, you needed to submit a written statement of facts and request for a hearing within seven (7) days.

As of the date of this letter, the Board has not received from you a written statement of facts and request for a hearing. Accordingly, you have waived your right to a hearing.

Effective June 11, 2024, pursuant to paragraph 12 of the Agreement, the Board **SUSPENDS your license to practice nursing for a minimum of three (3) years. You shall not practice as a nurse in Massachusetts until the Board provides you written notice that it has reinstated your license.**

This notice constitutes a final agency action. You are hereby notified that you have a right to appeal this *Final Notice: Suspension* within thirty (30) days of your receipt of this notice to the Supreme Judicial Court pursuant to M.G.L. c. 112, §64.
