- The Executive Director presented a communication from a student asking whether he
  has a right to partial course hours of a 150-hour Master Course after expressing
  dissatisfaction with the IEP and receiving a refund of his monies but not completing
  the program. The individual did not identify the IEP.
- Board Counsel stated that the Board regulation 237 CMR 13.06 outlines how students obtain credit for hours attended and added that the individual should file a complaint for their claims for the Board to investigate the allegations.
- The subcommittee agreed that the Board could not issue credit for incomplete hours pursuant to 237 CMR 13.06 to receive credit for any clock hours.
- 4. Discussed other matters not reasonably anticipated 48 hours in advance of meeting.
  - Brendan Driscoll mentioned as a point of information that wiring inspections after permitting do not occur in certain locales.
