- D. Edmonds stated that DESE is looking to the Board for clarity as to the expectations and allowances of Ch. 74 approved programs: a clear formalized process going forward. He briefly explained the program’s history and outlined allocation, enforcement, safety and health and 3-year review processes. In partnership with the Board students obtain at least 1575 hours with the Board granting 300 hours related and averaging 1275 hours through shop or cooperative education but no more than 2000hrs.
